- agricultural rural setting where farms are diverse and relatively large

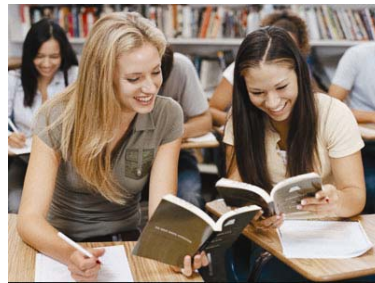


- distinct cultural groups: Hutterite communities, French communities, one First Nations community as well as many individuals with distinct cultural backgrounds

## Our Schools

- 29 schools including 13 Hutterite colony schools and 16 public schools (2 schools offer French programs)
- approximately 2300 students and 160 teachers
- school enrolments ranging from 10 students in a small school to 250 students in a larger Kindergarten to Grade 12 public school
- classes are taught from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM, Monday to Friday
- school year starts in the beginning of September and finishes at the end of June
- there are nine high schools with small class sizes and a pupil teacher ratio of 16:1



- school sports include volleyball, basketball, hockey, curling, soccer, cross-country running, skiing, badminton, baseball, softball, and track and field



- most schools offer a music, choral or visual arts program



- Career Technology Studies Program, where students pursue workplace experience in a variety of areas, is available in certain schools
- leaders in technology and Distance Education
